No.3 More than 60 years ago, scientists discovered interesting facts about sleep. While we are sleeping, our eyes move rapidly for some time. This type of sleep occurs a few times before we wake up in the morning. Scientists named it REM sleep. REM means “rapid eye movement”. There are periods of Non-REM sleep between those of REM sleep. Our brains are more active during REM sleep than they are during Non- REM sleep. We usually dream a lot during REM sleep. If we know more about sleep, we may find how we can sleep better.
